As per the decision of the **Syndicate in circulation dated 22.09.2025** I am by direction to inform you that the University has considered your application for affiliation and granted fresh affiliation to start a new Self-financing Arts and Science College in the name of "**C.K.S Arts and Science College [Co-Ed]**", Kakkathoppu Village, Chettikuppam Post, Gudiyatham Taluk, Vellore District from the academic year 2026-2027 as per (1). G.O. (Ms) No.66, Higher Education (E1) Department, dated 12.04.2017 and (2). **Report of the Inspection Commission sent by this University** and approved to grant provisional affiliation to start the following UG Degree courses in the above said new Arts and Science College for the academic year 2026-2027, **subject to the condition that the Management of the college**

- (i) **should be appointed qualified Principal and nine qualified teachers within a period of three months and subsequently to obtain qualification approval from the University, failing which the temporary affiliation granted will be cancelled and**
- (ii) **to obtain Certificate under section 37 (B) of Tamil Nadu Land Reforms (Land fixation and ceiling) Act, 1961 and to submit to the Government within three months as mentioned in the G.O in the reference 2nd cited and to submit the same to the University.**

1. **B.A. Tamil**
2. **B.Sc., Chemistry**
3. **B.Sc., Physics**
4. **B.Com.**
5. **B.Sc. Computer Science**

The provisional affiliation has been granted subject to the conditions of affiliation stipulated by the University. The sanctioned strength for the above UG courses are as follows:

3.	B.Sc., Physics	70

5.	B.Sc. Computer Science	50

The College may select Allied and Elective subjects for the above-mentioned courses and intimate the same to the Controller of Examinations as early as possible for approval.

CONDITIONS OF AFFILIATION:

1. Arrangement shall be made by the college for the conduct of university Examinations.
2. No donations shall be collected from the students seeking admission to any course of study in the college.
3. Excess admission shall never be made to any course over and above the sanctioned strength of the respective course(s).
4. **The Management of college shall not discontinue any existing course without prior permission from the University which should be intimated before the 30th September.**
5. The college shall only collect Tuition and other fees from the students at the rates as prescribed by the State Government/University.
6. In the interest of standard of P.C. Education, the guidelines prescribed by the University for the P.G. courses shall be followed. The admission to P.G. course will be considered on the guidelines determined by the Syndicate from time to time.
7. The guidelines with regard to infrastructure required for conducting the B.Sc. Computer Science course and qualifications for the teaching should be strictly adhered to.
8. The college should have (1) Separate lounge (2) Rest room (3) Toilet (4) Women Faculty etc.

9. A Librarian, Physical Director/Directress and a Medical officer with the prescribed qualification shall be appointed.
10. Number of teaching and non-teaching staff shall be appointed as per norms prescribed by the University/UGC/Government for each course including foundation course, allied and application-oriented subjects. As per the UGC Regulations 2010, teachers should be qualified with NET/ SET/Ph.D.
11. No teacher shall be appointed, if he/she has not fulfilled the qualifications as laid down by the University and UGC from time to time.
12. Non-teaching staff shall be paid as per pay scales of State Government/UGC prescribed from time to time.
13. An agreement shall be entered into with each teacher to be appointed as per the requirements. The college shall implement each one of the recommendations of the Inspection Commission.
14. The classrooms shall be according to the suggested U.G.C. norms.
15. The library should be strengthened, as suggested by the Inspection Commission. The library shall have common reading room and stack room as per standard prescribed by the UCC/Government.
16. The teacher should be paid as per pay scales of UGC/AICTE/Vith paid Commission of the State Government, as the case may be, and their salary should be made through Banks, by means of Cheque. This will be verified by the authorities from time to time.
17. The maximum number of students who may be admitted to each of the course shall not exceed the strength sanctioned by the University.
18. Laboratory shall be strengthened, as suggested by the Commission. The Laboratory shall have sufficient equipment's required for performing experiments prescribed for the courses of study. The laboratories shall also have adequate arrangement for gas supply, regular water supply and electricity. The safety standard shall be fully observed.
19. Necessary Hostel accommodation, Staff quarters, Playground are to be provided.
20. An agreement shall be entered into with each teacher to be appointed as per the requirements of the University/Tamil Nadu Private Colleges (Regulation) Act and Rules thereunder.
21. The posts of teacher and Head of the Departments wherever required for the proposed course shall be filled up before starting the course.
22. No teacher shall be appointed or shall be continued in service, who has attained the age of superannuation as may be prescribed by the Tamil Nadu Government.
23. Suitable leave rules for teaching and non-teaching staff be framed, generally in conformity with the State Government rules.
24. Approval shall be obtained from the University before appointing the teaching staff.
25. All conditions of affiliation laid down in Chapter XXVI Laws of the Madras University Calendar, Volume-1 2001 as amended shall be strictly followed.

26. Such other Rules and Regulations as may be generally prescribed from time to time by the University shall also be complied with.

27. If all the conditions of Provisional affiliation granted are not complied with by the end of the period fixed, then affiliation or approval shall cease automatically.

I am also to inform you that provisional affiliation to the above said course(s) granted to your college, for the academic year 2026-2027 will not be extended further (i.e. for the academic year 2027-2028) until and unless all the above conditions are satisfied in full. If the conditions are not fulfilled by the end of the academic year 2026-2027 as per Statute 44A of Chapter XXVI of the Laws of the Madras University Calendar Volume-I, 2001, the provisional affiliation granted for the above said course(s) will not be extended for the next year (i.e. for 2027-2028). No student shall be admitted without prior approval of the university for the academic year 2027-2028.

Further I am by direction to inform you to complete the admission on 31.07.2026 subject to the condition that the students admitted should earn the required percentage of attendance prescribed to appear for the First Semester Examination

You should apply for continuation of provisional affiliation to second year of the above said courses for the academic year 2027-2028 on or before **31.01.2027**, by submitting a request letter along with processing fee of **Rs.6,000 /- for each course** to be paid directly to the University Account maintained ***in favour of The Registrar in IOB, Thiruvalluvar University Branch, Serkkadu, Vellore-632 115*** (IFSC Code No. of IOB TVU Branch:IOBA0002484), (MICR Code No.632020014), (SB Account No.248401000000001) by way of RTGS/NEFT and CBS mode. *The college should mention the college code and UTR No. in the remittance challan.* **Submit original Remittance Challan to the University.**
