WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, CKS Educational Trust, Plot No.86/2, Kakkathoppu Village & Road, Chettikuppam Post Office, Gudiyatham Taluk & City, Vellore District – 635806, Tamil Nadu applied for grant of recognition to CKS College of Education, Plot/Khasara No.86/2-4 CENT, PLOT No.82-4.25 AC, Plot No.86/2-4, Kakkathoppu Village, Chettikuppam Post Office, Gudiyatham Taluk & City, Vellore District – 635806, Tamil Nadu for BA.B.Ed.BSc.B.Ed course online on 30.06.2015 for four year duration (integrated) under section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 and hardcopy received by Southern Regional Committee of NCTE on 14.07.2015.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, and the certificates received from the university, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Regional Committee, NCTE here by grants recognition to CKS College of Education, Plot/Khasara No.86/2-4 CENT, PLOT No.82-4.25 AC, Plot No.86/2-4, Kakkathoppu Village, Chettikuppam Post Office, Gudiyatham Taluk & City, Vellore District – 635806, Tamil Nadu for conducting BSc.B.Ed programme of four years duration (integrated) with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the academic sessions 2017-2018 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs.7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDR's shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

 4.  - j. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - k. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. if it so desires.
 - l. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **CKS College of Education, Plot/Khasara No.86/2-4 CENT, PLOT No.82-4.25 AC, Plot No.86/2-4, Kakkathoppu Village, Chettikuppam Post Office, Gudiyatham Taluk & City, Vellore District-635806, TamilNadu** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/SRCAPP14805/B.Sc.B.Ed./2017-2018/91894 dt. 17.02.2017 conducting B.Sc.B.Ed. programme of four years duration (integrated) with an annual intake of 100 students (2 units) from the academic session 2017-2018.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th – 15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN/FSCN in all RPRO cases asking them to submit all the required documents as per the 13 points. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.09.2020. The institution has submitted reply on 12.10.2020.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th meeting held on 13th – 14th December, 2021 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Final Show Cause was issued to the institution on 29.12.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 10.01.2022.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 406th Meeting held on 19th January, 2022 considered the matter and decided as under:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **CKS College of Education, Survey No. 82, 86/2B, Kakathoppu Village, Chettikuppam Post Office, Gudiyatham Taluk & City, Vellore District-635806, TamilNadu** for BSc. B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each".

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., **CKS College of Education, Survey No. 82, 86/2B, Kakathoppu Village, Chettikuppam Post Office, Gudiyatham Taluk & City, Vellore District-635806, TamilNadu** run by C.K.S. Educational Trust, Kakathoppu Village, Chettikuppam Post, Gudiyatham Taluk, Vellore District, TamilNadu-635806 for Continuation of recognition for B.Sc.B.Ed. programme for four-



years duration with annual intake of 2 basic units of 50 students each subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
